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## 0006. National Competitions

A discussion paper for Archery Australia.

### Overview

With the formation of a committee to review the format of the National Championships I would like to put forward the following for discussion.

### Objectives

- To put more focus on finding a National Champion.
- To lower costs for the Organising Committee.
- Encourage more entrants at a lower entry fee.
- Shorten the time frame by splitting the open nationals into two events.
- Concentrate on growing the attendance of the “rank and file” archers by having teams events.
- Create a qualification and a MQS to attend the Open events.

### Preamble

The primary objective of this discussion paper is to change the one large national championship into two smaller championships.

It should have the effect of increasing competition within categories and simplifying the organisation of the Nationals. That in turn may reduce the cost of running the events, reduce the need to have a very large venue and reduce the workload on the judges and volunteers.

The proposal is based on creating a Youth and Open National Championships structured to create more competition over a greater range of events.

A key part of this discussion paper is opportunity. A new open event entitled the Australian Field Open is to elevate the skill of field shooting into an annual international competition hosted in Australia.

The benefits of one nationals for open competitors is the one transportation cost, however, not everyone attends the Nationals to shoot all events. The deconstructing of the double FITA round into a FITA 1440 and a FITA 900 means two events, and twice the number of medals, but more importantly it offers variety and a new challenge for our national competitors.

In all cases we must promote competition and expand the growth of archery in this country to all levels.

## The Australian Open

To be held annually.

Proposed schedule would be;

**(March)**

Friday Practise/Registration

Saturday Qualifying rounds

Sunday Matchplay rounds

These championships would be limited to Compound and Recurve bow types.

Limited to open divisions only.

Entry would be limited by a MQS.

This is the premier event for international competition in this country.

As matchplay is its primary competition base it should form part of the selection process for the following years international events.

The winners shall be termed the *Australian Open Champion (category)*.

A team consisting of 3 archers from the same category.

The winning team members shall each receive a gold medal with the title *Australian Open Teams Champion (category)* and their names engraved on the perpetual trophy called the *Australian Open Teams Trophy (category)*.

## The Australian Field Open

To be held annually.

Proposed schedule would be;

**(May)**

Friday Practise/Registration

Saturday 24T Unmarked FITA Field (Qualification round)

Sunday 24T Marked FITA Field (Qualification round)  
Individual and Team Finals

These championships would be only be open to Compound, Barebow Recurve and Recurve bow types.

Limited to open divisions only.

Entry would be limited by a MQS.

The winners shall be termed the *Australian Field Open Champion (category)*.

### The Australian Field Open Teams Event

A team consisting of 3 archers. One of each bow type in the same gender.

The winning team members shall each receive a gold medal with the title *Australian Field Open Teams Champion (gender)* and their names engraved on the perpetual trophy called the *Australian Field Open Teams Trophy (gender)*.

*National 3Di Champion (category)*

*National Field Champion (category)* shall be those archers that win the combined Saturday and Sunday events. First place only.

*National Youth Champion (category)* shall be those archers that win the 3 combined events.

Each category can win the event.

The national competition calendar should be managed by the National Administration Manager (refer discussion paper 0004). Setting a reasonably fixed calendar shall go a long way to helping the RGBs set a fixed calendar.

### Summary

Shorter time frames, in conjunction with age restrictions and a MQS, shall make a lot more venues available to host these events. By adding in the Australian Field Open it provides more opportunities for archers to participate in multiple events or to just attend the desired events with, predominately, their peers.

Shorter time frames makes life easier for the organising committee, the volunteers and judges most of whom have trouble with 7 day events.

The introduction of a team trophy for more events is an enormous cost and may be offset with some sponsorship. By having a team competition open to all archers, and competing directly with RGB teams, should attract a lot more interest and thereby justifying the expenditure. AA may also wish to set a fee for archers entering a team to help offset the cost of the medals and perpetual trophies.
